



PILGRIMAGE TO TAIZÉ, FRANCE

JUNE 3-10, 2018

Our week in Burgandy will be spent immersed in the rhythm of the monastic community at Taizé. Thousands of young adults come to Taizé each year to join the Brothers in their daily call to prayer. So we, as older adults, will join them also. Meals and accommodation in the community are extremely simple. Bible study, prayer, teaching led by the Brothers, and conversations with other adults from all over the world are deep and profoundly meaningful.

Each person making this pilgrimage to Taizé will book their own flight. This will allow each participant freedom to travel on airline of choice, the ability to purchase a mileage or revenue ticket, and to extend travel on either side of our week in Taizé.

Given individual travel arrangements, we will plan to meet together on **Sunday, June 3, 2018 at 10:00 am** at the **Paris Gare de Lyon train station**. We will travel from Paris on the TGV high speed train to the Mâcon Loché station outside Mâcon. A relatively short bus ride from Mâcon through the French countryside will bring us to the village of Taizé. Once at Taizé we will be warmly welcomed by the Brothers to the community.

**Information will be provided to you for purchasing both TGV tickets and bus tickets in advance of your out-going flight from Houston.*

Please confirm your intention to participate by **January 15, 2018** with a **\$300 non-refundable check** payable to **St. Dunstan's Episcopal Church**. This payment will cover meals and accomodation at Taizé from Sunday dinner on June 3 through breakfast on June 10.
